The Chairman of the Board, Cheryl D. Cheryl has also served as the Vice-President of Gwinnett Pearls of Service, Inc. 501(c)(3), Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.

Prior to serving as the CBA Chairman of the Board, she served as on the Webmaster and Technology Liaison with CBA.

As the owner of her computer consultant business, Bowman Enterprise, for over 10 years, she has provided technology support to individuals and organizations in several states. She has a MAT Degree from Winthrop University, with a Major in Business Education and Minor in Computer Science. Her B.S.
